Feasibility Study Report: The consultant shall prepare and submit a Feasibility Study Report to the SDA at the end of the project duration.

For ALL of the above-mentioned Bids, the following tasks and responsibilities will have to be carried out by the successful Bidders:

Task 1	Conduct Market analysis, including concept feasibility.
Task 2	Determine the level of investment required to plan and implement the project.
Task 3	Estimate investment required and reward to be derived by the SDA from project.

Task 5	Proposed financing model and capacity raising strategy.
